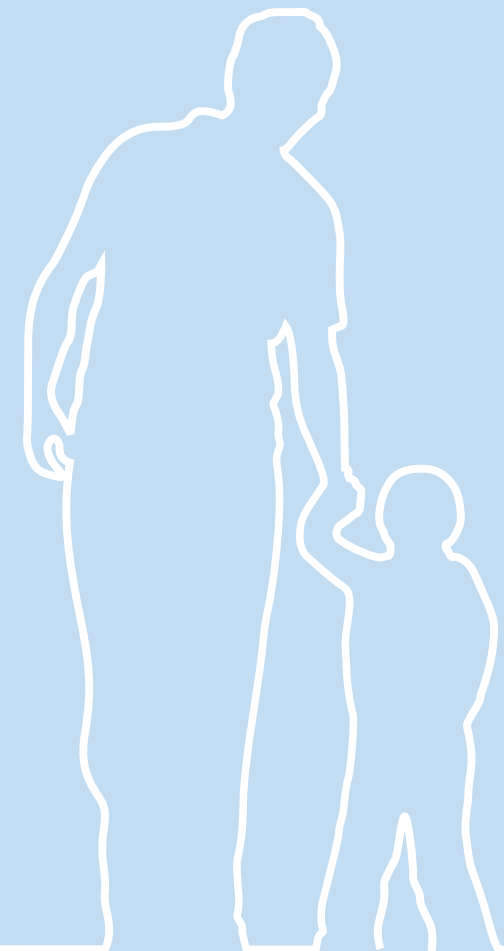

Strand 1.

Will offer 7-week courses to adults and their pre-school children, based on the principles of our existing PEEP (Peers Early Education Partnership) programs. PEEP courses are designed to specifically enhance learning and development in pre-school children through raising the confidence and awareness for the parents/carers. This is achieved through everyday activities such as play, singing and sharing books.

Strand 2.

Offers 7-week courses to 10-16 year olds with an appropriate adult, preferably a parent or carer. The courses will improve the young person's confidence and motivation and enable them to interact better with other family members. Participants will learn new skills through a range of active learning opportunities such as music production, sports, film making, art and design or car maintenance.

SOVA Volunteer

By working in partnership with SOVA families will also benefit from the support of a volunteer, who will keep participants fully engaged throughout their time on the project.

Volunteer Support

As a Volunteer you could be supporting a young person, parent or family by encouraging their participation in the courses.

Volunteers have been selected to help with making the project a success and would facilitate the feedback from young people or parents to project staff .
